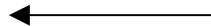
A WICCAN WITCH??!

This is precisely the art image FutureChurch has created of this Saint and are using in their literature. Unfortunately, this is no joke or stretch of anyone's imagination. Two Wiccan members themselves verified three features in FutureChurch's rendition of this Saint as distinctly Wiccan.



FutureChurch's reconstruction of this devoted disciple of our Lord Jesus dressed in both **Wiccan hood and robe with the pointed sleeves**, bearing a **Wiccan athame** (blade) in her waist sash (for directing power during rituals), and the **first and second finger "V" formation** (*mano cornuta*) held upward representing the Horned "God."*

**WICCA, A Guide for the Solitary Practitioner*, by Scott Cunningham, page 42, describes the "V" formation of the first and middle finger held upward signifies the Horned God.

What is the Wiccan Religion? According to Scott Cunningham in *WICCA, A Guide For the Solitary Practitioner*, the "core of Wicca" is "a joyous union with nature." *Wicca* is an "earth based religion" where there is no supernatural. All is natural including the "spiritual." The personal, supernatural transcendent Creator God revealed to His chosen people Israel and through Jesus Christ to His Church does not exist. **There is nothing above nature and its energy forces**, which Wiccans merely personify by calling them "God" and "Goddesses." Wicca embraces the doctrine of reincarnation and utilizes "magic," which to them is not supernatural but merely the directing of **natural energies found in all creation**. Most Wiccans do not believe in the Devil or Satan. They correctly describe themselves as pagan because they flatly reject the Christian concept of the supernatural and an almighty personal God. **The "Goddess" Sophia (wisdom), presented by FutureChurch as an object of worship, is just such a personification (not a person) and is thus an idolatrous substitute for the Triune God of Christianity.**
